Meet some new purrsonalities!

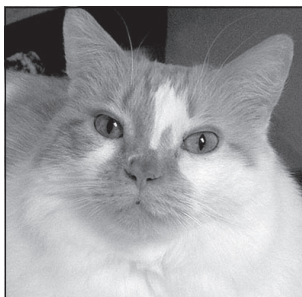


Chloe

Log in to PayPal or use the link from the StreetCats Web site.

1. Click on **Send Money** tab. With PayPal, you can make your payment via debit, credit, or bank transfer.
2. Pay to: cats@streetcatstulsa.org
3. After you put in the amount you want to donate, **click on the PERSONAL tab below; then choose GIFT**. This ensures that neither you nor StreetCats will incur a processing fee.
4. On the next page, **if you scroll down before you hit**

the SEND MONEY button, there is a box where you can put a note. This is helpful if the donation is a memorial or honorarium gift, or if you want your thank you letter to be e-mailed to you or sent to a different address than the one in which your PayPal account is registered.
