www.petfinder.com: Post pictures & info of cats that need homes online; listed by location and type/breed

www.tulsa.craigslist.org: List cats for adoption or find cats needing homes or lost cats.

Tulsa World newspaper: Run an ad and we suggest you charge an adoption fee for your cat to screen out questionable adopters.

Vet Offices: They sometimes take kittens and adopt them to good homes or you can post flyers of cats needing homes

Southern Agriculture and related stores: Can foster flyers of cats needing homes
